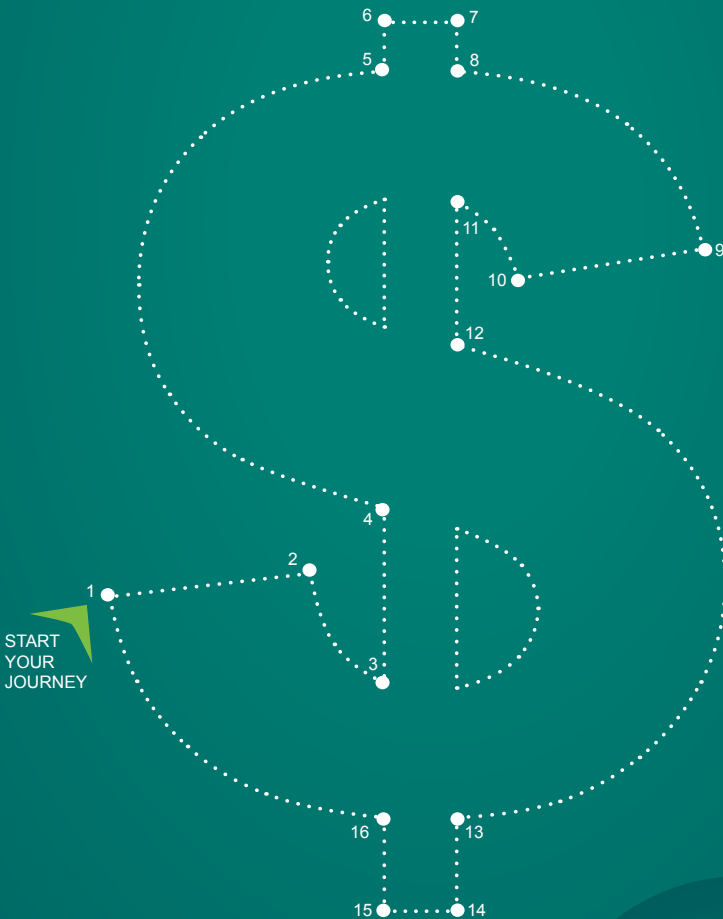

**NMC's TUITION** averages one-third that of a four-year college or university.

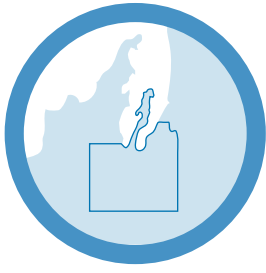

# Financial Aid & Scholarships



If you live in Grand Traverse County, NMC's average scholarship pays for almost half of a semester's full-time tuition. Scholarships don't have to be paid back, keeping more money in your pocket.

**TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID**

- Grants and scholarships**: Money you usually don't have to pay back
- Work-study**: Money you earn to help pay for educational expenses
- Loans**: Money you have to pay back

**SCHOLARSHIPS COVER MORE THAN TUITION**  
They're available for expenses like housing, food, childcare, books, supplies, equipment and transportation costs. NMC students receive more than \$1.8 million in scholarships each year.

**LOTS OF REASONS BESIDES GRADES**  
qualify you for a scholarship, including financial need, where you live, the program you're studying, and if you're a parent.

**WANT TO SAVE MORE?**  
Start in high school, as a dual-enrolled or Early College student. Tuition is paid for by your school district, meaning it's free to you.
