4. **Contract Evaluation:** What student activities (thinking, research, writing, annotating, etc.) undertaken in the honors project will be assessed in determining the "grade" for the project? What standards (clarity, accuracy, precision, relevance, logic, depth/breadth, fair-mindedness, and significance, standard English, support of general education outcomes, depth of research, etc.) will be used to assess the quality of student work done in this project? Be specific in the description of your standards of evaluation. Attach a copy of the evaluation rubric, if you use one.
