In-district students

(Grand Traverse County)

- ☐ Community College Guarantee will cover all tuition and fees for the high school class of 2024 and beyond!

Out-of-district students

- ☐ Community College Guarantee will cover more than half the cost (half the tuition and all fees). Pell grant funds can be used to cover the out-of-district difference.

NMC bachelor's degrees

- ☐ The Community College Guarantee does not apply to students enrolled in NMC's bachelor degree programs (Marine Technology or Maritime Technology). Those students are still eligible for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, which offers up to \$27,500 over five years (up to \$5,500 per year).

What's required?

- ☐ Must enroll within 15 months of high school graduation
- ☐ Must be enrolled full time (at least 12 credits, typically 4 classes)
- ☐ Completing the FAFSA
- ☐ For more information go to Michigan.gov/mistudentaid

What other funds are available?

- ☐ An additional \$1,000 Michigan Achievement bonus award for Pell-eligible students.
- ☐ Automatic matching to other scholarships

- > There are no income or GPA eligibility requirements
- > No maximum credit limit
- > Students can earn more than one associate degree or certificate
