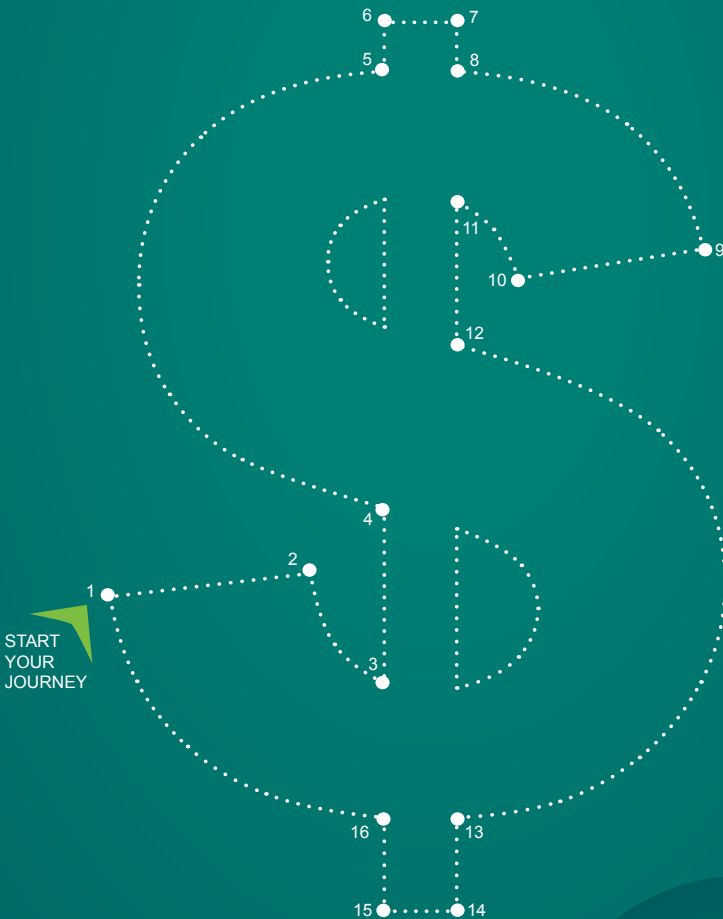

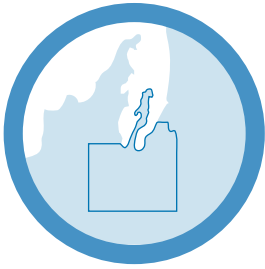

If you live in Grand Traverse County, NMC's average scholarship pays for almost half of a semester's full-time tuition. Scholarships don't have to be paid back, keeping more money in your pocket.
