- 3. Student must complete the required segments in the Drafting and Design classes with a grade of B or better, achieve the required competencies to articulate the class, and receive endorsement from their instructor(s).
- 4. NMC instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the course objectives, course work, and assessments, and if necessary a NMC written competency evaluation.
- 5. Articulation credits are subject to fees.
