General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Student applies and is enrolled at NMC.
2. Student completes the TBAISD CTC class with a grade of B or better and achieves the required competencies to articulate the class.
3. NMC instructor evaluates the student's learning based on the course objectives, course work, and course assessments, and if necessary an NMC written competency evaluation.
4. Articulation credits are subject to fees.
5. Credit must be requested within two (2) years of completing the TBAISD CTC program.
