The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from high school occupational and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to the **Law Enforcement A A S Degree**. Program is offered at **Traverse City Mi.**

### General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Enrollment in the NMC Law Enforcement Program.
2. Completion of outcomes comparable to the NMC Law Enforcement Program.
3. Grade of B or better in the CTC program. Articulation credits are subject to fees.
4. TBAISD CTC and NMC Faculty approval as evidenced by a completed application for articulated credit signed by TBAISD CTC and NMC faculty.
5. Credit will be granted after successfully completing the next successive NMC Law Enforcement course.
6. Credit must be requested within two (2) years of completing the TBAISD CTC program.
7. MFR or EMT certification required for HAH 200 credit.
8. Minimum of eighty (80) hours of field observation required for LWE 195 credit.


