Articulation Agreement Northwestern Michigan College and Traverse City Area Public Schools

Statement of Intent

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a mechanism for awarding ENG 221-Creative Writing articulated credit for those TCAPS students who successfully complete Advanced Creative Writing Workshop I and II courses through the Front Street Writers Series. The course ENG 221 does not satisfy NMC's ENG 111 or ENG 112 English Composition requirements.

The following criteria must be met for the course being considered for articulation.

- 1. The course objectives/outcomes/competencies must be comparable to the NMC course.
- 2. The high school instructor must sign the articulation form signifying the student has demonstrated competency in the course objectives as evidenced through both Advanced Creative Writing Workshop I and II.
- 3. A final grade of B or better is required in the high school course to receive articulated credit.
- 4. Articulation of credit must be requested within three years of graduation from high school.
