- Enter the U.S. not more than 30 days before the start date listed on your visa.

Aviation/Flight Training *TSA* Requirements

The United States Transportation Security Administration (TSA) must approve your application for flight training prior to commencing training in the U.S. Your I-20 form is included with this letter and is the first step in obtaining approval from TSA. The following steps must be completed before you depart your country:

1. Go online to: www.flightschoolcandidates.gov. Select “Create New Student Account” from the top right of the page. Complete the required information, making certain the information you enter matches your passport information, then submit your form. Shortly after you submit this information, you will receive an email with a User ID and Password.
2. Return to www.flightschoolcandidates.gov and enter your User ID and Password in the fields provided. You will then be required to complete the online AFSP application forms and submit them. Please note:
 - a. During online application process you will see questions regarding “Resident Start Date” and “Resident End Date”. These questions relate to how long you have been living at your current address.
 - b. For Step 7 the course ID please enter “101” and for training category use “Category 3”. You will then need to enter the aircraft type you will be training in which will be Cessna 152/172/172rg/Decathlon/Seaplane.
3. Once submitted the Alien Flight Student Program (AFSP) will contact Northwestern Michigan College (NMC), the flight training provider, for confirmation of your NMC application and admission details. Once that confirmation is received by AFSP from NMC, you will receive an email with further information about TSA approval and regarding the USD \$130 processing fee.
4. Pay the processing fee using the instructions sent to you.
5. Once the fee is paid, the application will be sent for consideration and you, the candidate, and the flight training provider (NMC) will be notified of a preliminary decision. If approved, the candidate will receive confirmation details with instructions on how to submit official fingerprints for clearance.
6. Submit fingerprints at the approved location in your country, as outlined in the instructions sent to you, and pay the Fingerprint Fee of USD \$150 (may vary by country).
7. When fingerprints have been submitted an approval email will be sent to the candidate and the training provider.

Please Note: Both M-1 or F-1 visa and TSA approval must be obtained before any flight training commences. It is **strongly** recommended that each student/candidate begins this process as soon as this information is received. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure appropriate visa and TSA clearances are in place before flight training begins. NMC Aviation will require copies of these documents prior to the student’s flight training beginning.
