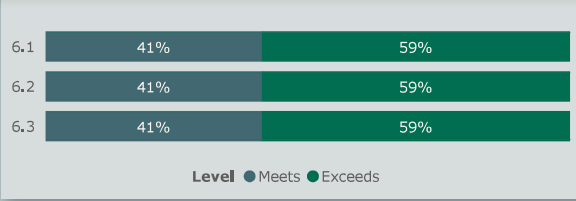
- 3 = Exceeds level

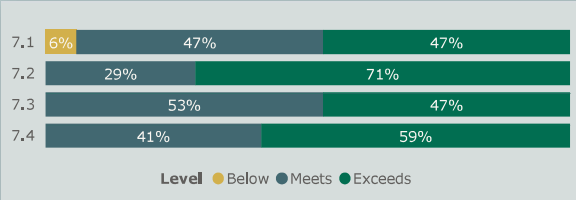
6. Demonstrates the skills necessary to provide a safe work environment for patients and staff, including knowledge of OSHA requirements and in-depth knowledge of infection control.

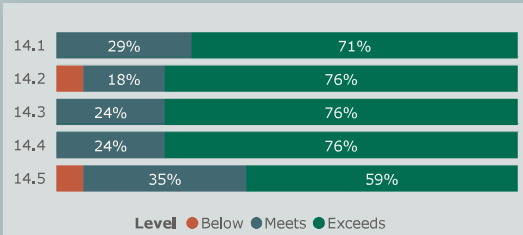
13. Demonstrates basic office skills that are applicable to the business side of dentistry including computer hardware and software skills.
