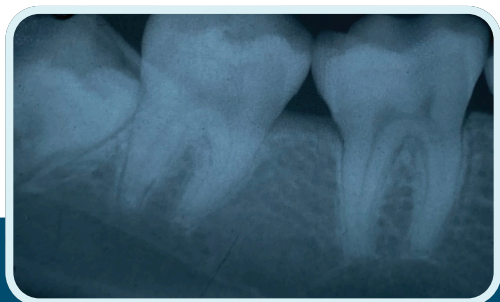

Upon successful completion, along with a favorable background check, you'll be eligible for the Michigan state board exam. Passing the exam earns you the title of Registered Dental Assistant, allowing you to practice in the field right away.
