DAY 2 - MILANO/BOLOGNA - Friday, May 28

Arrive in Milano, Italy

Train Transfer to Bologna (Approx 2 hrs)

Hotel Check-in & Refresh

Orientation and historical walking tour of the Anatomical Theatre and

University- Guided introduction to Bologna's historic university district, including the Anatomical Theatre and key sites connected to the University of Bologna. The visit explores the development of scientific education, medicine and academic life in one of Europe's oldest universities.

Welcome Dinner - The group will be taken for an authentic dinner with a wide variety of menu options to cater all diets.

STEAM International High School Exchange -

The Steam International High School in Bologna, recognized by the Italian Ministry of Education as an experimental four-year program, combines Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics to prepare students for future innovation. Funded by Confindustria Emilia and the Veronesi Institute, the school trains future designers, robotics experts, and automotive engineers through a mix of theoretical and practical learning, including 300 hours of work-based experience. Half of the courses are taught in English.

Lamborghini Museum has been updated to become the Museum of technologies, where the iconic models and tour of the production line tell the story of over 50 years of innovation. Mudetec offers the students an interactive experience, also thanks to the new driving simulator that amplifies the thrills and the discovery of the vehicles on display

Enzo Ferrari Museum and and F1 Simulator

Experience-The museum tells the Ferrari story by delving deep into the Prancing Horse's extraordinary roots and taking visitors on a magnificent journey via its most famous and successful F1 Cars, legendary sports prototypes and GTs, and of course the road cars that have set the benchmark of the entire car industry. **The experience includes access to the F1 Simulator**, where visitors can step into a semi-professional cockpit and virtually race on iconic circuits. This thrilling, hands-on activity offers an immersive way to explore the world of Ferrari engineering and driving performance.

Maserati Factory Tour - Maserati Factory was founded in Bologna in 1914 and moved to its current Headquarters in Modena in 1937.

Visit to Lingotto Factory, FIAT & Pista

500-The historical FIAT test track and access ramp on the roof of Lingotto opens to the public through an art project in dialogue with a new hanging garden created by FIAT.

National Automobile Museum (MAUTO) – Guided visit to the permanent collection and interactive learning experience on the evolution of the automobile, electric engines and sustainable mobility.

DAY 8 - TURIN - Thursday, June 3

Breakfast & Day Briefing

Turin Historical Walking Tour – Piazza

Castello, the Royal Palace and Royal Museums, Palazzo Madama, the Cathedral, Via Roma and Piazza San Carlo. The visit

provides an overview of Turin's Roman origins, Savoy history, Baroque architecture and role as the first capital of Italy. Valentino Park and Castello del Valentino – Exterior visit and interpretation of the UNESCO-listed Savoy residence; interior access only if a scheduled visit is available.

Lunch Break (Not Included)

Afternoon Canoe or rowing activity on the

River Po – Supervised group session

with qualified instructors, safety equipment and a land-based alternative in case of unsuitable weather or river conditions. Subject to operator confirmation, participant requirements and budget.

Formula 1 Circuit de Monaco – Circuit Route
Opportunity to follow the layout of the famous street circuit used for the Monaco Grand Prix. The route runs along public roads normally open to traffic and allows participants to identify some of the most iconic sections of the track, including the Fairmont Hairpin, the tunnel, and the Waterfront **NB: Subject to the official 2027 Formula 1 calendar**, event access and budget: include the public fan zone and/or a trackside practice-session ticket. Ticketed grandstand access should be quoted as an optional supplement rather than included in the base programme. TBD

Top Cars Collection of H.S.H. the Prince of Monaco - Visit to the private car collection of the Prince of Monaco, featuring historic vehicles, racing models, and luxury cars. The exhibition provides an overview of the evolution of the automobile and highlights the strong connection between the Principality and motorsport.
