

Wireless

NMC offers free, secured wifi across all buildings on campus. Students can use their NMC ID and password to log in to the student network, with a guest network available to everyone.

Depending on your device, the steps to connect to wireless may look different. Open up Settings, and go to your Network settings. Select Network and Internet, and click on Wi-Fi.

For students who are currently registered, they will have access to the NMC-STUDENT network.

Select NMC-STUDENT and it will open a configuration page. It will ask you for an identity and password. This is the same as your NMC ID that you use when you log on to the website and to machines on campus. If you change your NMC password, make sure to update it in your wireless settings.

Some devices may ask for a certificate before allowing you to connect. For this, select Do Not Validate.

For those who are not students or otherwise do not know their login information and need to access wireless, you can use NMC-GUEST.

Click on "NMC-GUEST" and it will begin to connect. You will then be directed to a web page to accept the Terms of Service

Your device will finish connecting once you click "I agree".

If you are having troubles connecting to wireless, the Technology Helpdesk can offer hands-on support. Being able to connect is the first step to jumping into the services offered by NMC.
